
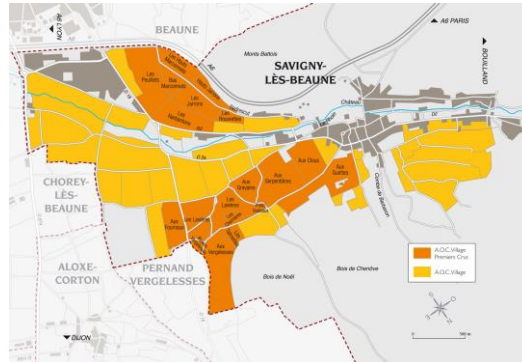

Descriptive

Founded in 1844 by Louis Violland, this company is one of the oldest in Burgundy. Office were located in the heart of Beaune (the former 'Rue de la Poste'), in the ancient buildings from the 12th and 13th century. Underneath those beautiful cellars, you could find some exceptional vintages. Many of those wines are regularly selected at the Tastevinage of the Clos Vougeot, which proves the authenticity and the quality of Léon Louis-Violland wines.

Vinification & maturing

The grapes have been picked by hand and 100% destalked. Cold maceration at first for a maximum extraction of the colour. Long alcoholic fermentation in open vats and maturation for 12 months in French oak barrels (30% new oak barrels).

Tasting notes

Deep intense red color. Good brilliance.
Elegant and powerful bouquet, with mossy, strawberry aromas.
It has discreet tannins and low acidity. Light, fine structure producing a feminine image.

Food pairing

Excellent with any light dish of red or white meat.
Highly flavoured sauces should be avoided.
