Vinification & maturing

Harvesting by hand and maceration 2 to 3 days and pressing.
Maturation: 100% in oak barrels

Tasting notes

Nice pink colour, on the nose fine aromas of cherry and red fruits, round, fresh and easy to drink.
The Pinot Noir is the only grape variety in Alsace for red or rosé wines.
This rosé is with some small bubbles which is typical of a spring Pinot Noir.
It's a charming wine!

Pork meals or andouillettes are also very good with this wine.
