Appellation : Côtes de Thongue (IGP).
Soil : Calcareous-Clay.
Age of the vines : 20-25 years old.
Pruning : Trellising on thread with pruning in Guyot and in Royat.
Harvest : Sorting of the harvest.
Yield : 70 hl/ha.

Vinification & maturing

After direct pressing the settling is carried out at 7°C, over 48 hours.
Vinification at 18°C. Matured in vat for 4 months.

Tasting notes

Pretty pale rose colour with bright glints.
The nose has powerful rich fruit notes : Raspberry, Strawberry and Cherry. Soft on entry, the palate reveals a touch of liveliness. Fresh with delicate hints of berry fruits.

Aperitif and summer dishes.
