



Wine: Saint-Aubin 1,cru “ Les Murgers des Dents de Chien”
Domaine Des Meix
Vintage: 2009
Grape: Chardonnay 100%
Alcohol: 13%

Descriptive

A close neighbour of Montrachet, lying between Chassagne and Puligny, Saint Aubin is a wine-growing village in the southern part of the Côte de Beaune, the heartland of the great white burgundies. The area covered by its communal appellation includes 20 Premiers Crus “climats”.

Vinification & maturing

The grapes have been picked by hand and immediately pressed at low pressure. Long alcoholic and malolactic fermentation (over a 3 months' period) to give a good body to the wine. Maturation in stainless steel vats for a maximum freshness both on the nose and on the palate.

Tasting notes

This Saint-Aubin has a nice gold colour.
Young, this wine develops aromas of white flowers, orange blossom, flint and almond. With age, it shows the richness: beeswax and honey, almond paste, amber and cinnamon.
It is very rich, fleshy and very full. This wine is a noble wine of the Côte de Beaune.
