



This Château is an invitation to travel through time. In the 12th century, the Knights of Saint John of Jerusalem established a hospice here to care for crusaders and pilgrims. Cabernet-Sauvignon vines were planted on the estate to provide wine for mass. Time is still a willing accomplice today, allowing the wine to fully develop elegance and body.

A nice and shimmering robe with golden brown reflections. A delicate bouquet where scents of gingerbread and candied fruit mix together.

Very delicate in mouth with a magnificent balance revealing silky aromas and subtle woody notes.
