



The “Château Tour Saint-Germain” is located in the north of Bordeaux, in Berson, three kilometres from Blaye “Citadel of Bordeaux Wines” and the estuary of the Gironde. Thanks to the proximity of the estuary, the vineyard benefits from a temperate climate, sufficiently rainy and mild in winter. The diversity of the soils clay-limestone, clay-silica, clay-gravel and gravel, is a characteristic of the estate.

Vinification

Maceration for a period of 20 to 25 days and in thermo-regulated concrete vats for 18 to 24 month. 6 month in oak barrels

Ready to drink now, this wine will keep for at least 2 to 5 years

This wine has an intense ruby red colour and a lovely rich bouquet, offering a fine oakiness accompanied by beautiful floral scents.

On the palate, it reveals an excellent structure, with round, ripe tannins in perfect harmony with an elegant woodiness.
